Kyra Lanae's testimony

And this began her journey to oneness with Jesus Christ.

It was during those early months that God began to peel back the layers of filth, guilt and shame in her life. God began to reveal His perspective and love for Kyra Lanae and for the first time in her life she began to feel



valuable, special, loved and wanted. Everything that she was searching for in her life—love, value, acceptance, satisfaction and purpose—was found in Christ.

Two of the scriptures that became ingrained in her were:

Song of Songs 4:7, "You are altogether beautiful, my darling, beautiful in every way" (NLT) and

Colossians 2:9-10, "For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body. So you also are complete through your union with Christ, who is the head over every ruler and authority" (NLT).

These scriptures became her anchor, reminding her of how God viewed her and her identity in Christ. While Kyra Lanae began to bask in that reality, God pressed upon her heart to write a book about her testimony and His greatness. Still influenced by some of her self-perceived inadequacies, she resolved to one day compile a book of several women's testimonies. In her mind, her insignificant testimony would merely fill a few pages. She thought that in order to fulfill what God put on her heart she would need

a dozen other contributors to fill a book. As years went by, Kyra Lanae kept looking at the note she made to herself on her phone to write a book, but never put it into action.

Fast forward about three years. While on assignment by God at her former place of employment, God began to transition Kyra Lanae. The crisis of her suicidal eight-year-old son, summoned her attention. While digesting the fact that her son needed help and she was dealing with a devastating situation, she was convinced that even in this dark situation. God would do something amazing through. In order to give her son the care and attention that was vital to his safety, Kyra Lanae resigned her job since they were unable to accommodate her scheduling needs. Knowing that her loss of employment would bring on financial challenges, she began to share her situation and request help from others.

Soon after, Kyra Lanae started a "Beauty for Ashes" campaign, explaining that while her situation seemed grim, God would create something beautiful out of it. It was that train of thought that caused Kyra Lanae to reflect back on the many

dark situations in her life that God turned around. As several things came to mind, she began to write them down. It was in that moment that God resurrected the notion for Kyra Lanae to write a book that would reflect her testimony of His transforming power in her life. And thus, Beauty for Ashes: The Transformation of my Life's Darkest Moments was born.
